

HEPATITIS A - RISKS & SYMPTOMS

You are at increased risk of being infected with the virus if you:

- Are homeless/transient
- Use IV or non-IV drugs
- Have sex with an infected person
- Are a man who has sex with men
- Are in jail or have recently been in jail
- Touch objects or eat food that someone with a hepatitis A infection handled
- Have chronic liver disease

Wash your hands with soap and water after using the bathroom or changing diapers and before eating and preparing food.
